
Adult Day Services:

Adult Day Services Benefits

- Reduces readmission and emergency department visits¹
- Families have primary care of loved ones
- Provides supervised care while living at home (74% of participants live in private residences)²
- Services designed for seniors (64%) and younger adults with disabilities (36%)³
- Participants engage in social and therapeutic activities during the day
- Enhances the quality of life of participants and their families⁴
- 5,700 adult day centers in the U.S.⁵ (8% of all regulated long term care providers)⁶
- More funding for adult day services <u>decreases Medicaid costs</u> by reducing full-time institutional care while still providing consistent health monitoring
- Helps avoid Medicare costs
